## Observations Y-1

The College should constitute its governing council at the earliest & it should meet regularly.

Efforts should be made to acquire own building. Need to improve all basic facilities.

The college needs more number of permanent teachers.

Steps should be taken to establish a good library with basic facilities.

More number of books and journals need to be procured in order the meet the requirements of the existing students strength According to Govt. and Department of Collegiate Education orders Local MLA must be the President of the college development council. The Governing council should be Constitute under the Chairmanship of the MLA. Many letters wrote to Dr. Rafeeq Ahmed MLA Tumkur Assembly constituency to constitute governing council and asked to call a meeting immediately.

Entire campus including laboratory wing was in use of Govt. first grade women college. Steps will be taken to construct a new building with the permission and sanction of allotment from the department.

Basic facilities like water. Toilet classrooms, ladies waiting room are provided and the other facilities like separate reading room. Library will be provided in due course.

Permanent lecturers are transfered from other colleges all the Department permanent and full time lecturers as needed.

Books worth Rs. 9.00 lakh are supplied from the Department. We asked Department to sanction Rs. 20.00 lakh for the purchase of library books during 2017-18. In this amount more number of books and journals will be purchased according to students strength.

There are only two computers in the college. More number of computers with internet facility should be provided to students and teachers

- The teaching staff should be deputed for seminars and conferences. They should be encouraged to publish articles /papers in research Journals.
- The teachers should be encouraged to obtain minor/major research projects.

Steps should be taken to acquire public addressing system. projector, and CCTV surveillance in the college.

Jnana sangama programme is implemented in this college. Under this scheme college will be provided digital library, smart class room, Teleeducation facility, Maintainance of attendence through tablets. More number of computers laptop and internal facility will be provided by the Department in this scheme. Besides this Laptops are supplied for SC/ST students from the department. This year also SC/ST and including General students will get laptops from the Department. Jindal Foundation donated 20 computers and are ready for students use.

There are 20 permanent lecturers and they all are deputed for seminars and conferences. Where ever necessary Teachers are benefitted under CAS if they publish articles/ papers in research journals.

 Our College is newly established, and the college is not recognized u/s 2f & 12b and NAAC. So there are no chances of obtaining minor / major projects.

Steps will be taken to arrange industryacademia interaction to encourage students in getting jobs their completion of Degree.

We have purchased public addressing system and projectors as per our requirements. Jnana Sangama Programme is implemented by the government. It will provides 19 CCTV, Ups -2KV Battery and solar panel. Beside this we have installed 16 CC TVs in the class rooms, laboratories and in the campus. The complete campus is in surveillance including all class rooms.
