English: Internship Programme

Max. Marks: 100

4 hrs(3 credits)/Week

The Internship Programme involves the submission of a mini project or report of the hands-on experience students have gained after going to the field work such as teaching English language and literature in schools or similar institutions, visiting media houses or conducting interviews of English language users/authors/readers. Students may conduct such a fieldwork in their own institutions also.

Objectives:

The main objective of the programme is to give larger exposure to students beyond classroom and enhance their learning ability.

To make students self-learners and inculcate leadership qualities in them

To develop critical analysis and writing skills in students

Learning outcomes:

After the completion of the Internship programme, students are expected

to reflect on their hands-on experience,

to be an independent learner

to capture their experiences in writing clearly.

Internship Report

Students shall submit a report of their hands-on experience of not less than 15 pages (Appendix: 01).

Internship Completion Certificates:

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Student declaration (Appendix: 02)

Students shall obtain a certificate of completion from the head of the concerned branch or institution (Appendix: 03).

Guidance: Students shall carryout the Internship programme under the guidance of a particular teacher who shall guide them through all the stages and certify the same, which shall be countersigned by the head of the institution such as the Principal (Appendix: 04).

Assessment: Internal assessment is to be carried out by the concerned supervisor. The dissertation is to be evaluated by an external examiner.
