

Tumakuru and places of Biological interest :

Tumakuru is one of the 30 districts of Karnataka is designated as a Smart City under the Smart city Programme of Prime Minister. It is about 70 km from Bangalore a state capital. It has many places of tourist interest and a paradise for Botanists. A glimpse of botanical interest and tourist attractions are highlighted below.

Timmalapura forest is about 20 km from the city of Tumakuru is a home of several wild animals such as sambar, sloth bear, Panther and rare land turtles. It is a sanctuary of **Land Turtles**. Similarly, **Black buck sanctuary** at Mydenahalli near Madhugiri Taluk is home of Black bucks and antelops. **Siddarabhetta** is 28 km from Tumakuru is an emporium of medicinal plants and some rare and endangered plants. It is known as Hill of saints and trekker's paradise with caves and temples.

Other places of interest are **Devarayanadurga** is a place of rocky hills surrounded by Dry deciduous forest with many rare, endangered plants and the hill tops dotted with several temples including the Yoganarasimha and the Bhoganarasimha. **Namada Chilume**, a natural spring considered sacred and is also considered as the origin of the Jayamangali and Shimsha rivers.

"Chennakeshava" and the **"Gangadhareshvara"** temple constructed during Hoysala period are the master pieces seen in Kaidala, few km from Tumakuru.

Shivagange is a mountain peak with a height of 804.8 meters is a pilgrimage center is 20 km from the Town of Tumakuru is also known as *Dakshina Kashi* is having many temples. A historical rock statue of Nandi or Basavanna carved on top of a steep rock is architectural paradise. Several springs such as Agasthyatheertha, Kanvatheertha, Kapilatheertha, Pathala Gange etc. are found on this hill.

Krishi Vigyan Kendra (KVK), Hirehalli a research station for horticultural crop part of Indian Institute of Horticultural Research, Bangalore is abode many exotic and indigenous hybrid fruits produced by the scientists of the institute.

The **Narasimha Swamy temple** at Seebi is located in the Sira taluk of Tumakuru district, is just 20 km north of Tumakuru city. Temple is a Dravidian structure.

Siddaganga mutt headed by Sri Sri Sri Shivakumara swamiji well known as **"Nededaduva Devaru"** has completed 110 years and working for the cause of education of this area. A mutt with 10,000 resident students with **"Dasoha"** every day to pilgrims who visit the mutt.
