

## MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

### PREAMBLE

**Whereas**, Mangalore University which is well known for interdisciplinary research and training in science and technology was established in 1980.

**Whereas**, Tumkur University was established in 2004 by an Act of the Karnataka Government with Tumkur District as its Jurisdiction. In the beginning, the University was offering six PG courses and there were about forty five affiliated colleges offering graduate programmes in the faculty of Arts, Science, Commerce, Education and Law. Presently, the University offers twenty PG courses such as MA (Kannada), MA (English), MA (History), MA (Economics), MA (Political Science), MA (Sociology), Master of Social Work, M.Sc. (Math.), M.Sc. (Chemistry), M.Sc. (Physics), M.Sc. (Biochemistry), M.Sc. (Biotechnology), M.Sc. (Psychology), M.Sc. (Environmental Science), M.Sc. (Electronic Media), MS (Communication), M.Sc. ( Library & Information Science), M.Com., M.Ed. and MBA in the University departments and affiliated colleges. The total number of affiliated colleges of the University has gone up to eighty four. Total strength of the students in University and affiliated colleges are 3,219 and 27,481 respectively.

**Whereas**, Tumkur University desires to establish academic collaboration with Institutions of excellence in Science and Technology in the country and Mangalore University is one such institution chosen for the collaboration.

### SCOPE OF AGREEMENT

This MOU is signed between Mangalore University as First Party and Tumkur University as Second Party for the purpose of Academic and Research Collaboration that will encompass exchange of members of faculty between the two parties. In addition, effort will be made to develop joint training and research programmes that will be pursued in collaborative spirit.
