Note:

1. The Candidates who have passed UGC/CSIR (JRF) Examination/NET/SLET/K-SET/GATE/ Teacher Fellowship shall have to apply in Form B. The merit list of such candidates will be prepared on the basis of 50% of marks secured in the interview and 50% marks in Master's Degree Examination. In case of candidates securing equal percentage of marks from both Masters Degree Examination and marks secured in the Interview, such candidates who have secured higher percentage in the Bachelor's Degree Examination will be placed higher in ranking.

2. The candidates who have passed UGC/CSIR (JRF)/SLET/K-SET/GATE or teacher fellowship are exempted from appearing for the Entrance Test. However, if they wish to apply for Ph.D. Entrance Test, they may also apply by filling

Form-A and paying separate fee.

3. 50% of the seats are reserved for the candidates who have passed UGC/CSIR (JRF)/SLET/K-SET/GATE or teacher fellowship and 50% for the candidates appearing for the Ph.D. Entrance Test.

- 4. In case of non-availability of candidates from either category, viz., candidates who have passed UGC/CSIR (JRF)/SLET/K-SET/GATE or teacher fellowship and Ph.D. Entrance Test candidates, the seats shall be allotted to other category and vice versa.
- 5. The medium of instruction, examination and submission of thesis will be in English, except in the case of Indian languages.
- 6. As per Government Rules and Regulations Seats will be reserved for persons with disability.

Eligibility to Apply for Admission to Ph.D. Programme

- i. Any candidate who has obtained a Post-Graduate Degree from a recognized University including foreign students (sponsored by their Embassies) and sponsored candidates securing not less than 55% marks at the Post-Graduate Degree shall be eligible to apply for the Ph.D. Degree Programme.
- ii. In the case of SC/ST/Cat-I/Physically challenged candidates, and those who are appointed on regular basis prior to March 31, 1992 as teachers, librarians and physical education personnel in colleges and University Departments, the minimum marks shall be 50% provided they (i.e., employees) are continuing in service at the time of submission of application for registration.
- iii. If the results of Master's Degree are declared in the form of grades/credits/cumulative points in their marks cards/transcripts, such grades/points shall be converted into percentage to assess the minimum eligibility criteria as specified above in Regulations i and ii.

General Instructions:

- 1. Applications will be received on all the days between 10.00 a.m to 5.00 p.m except on Sundays and general Holidays
- 2. Attested copies of all relevant documents should be enclosed.
- 3. In case the candidates claiming reservation fail to enclose the supporting documents, their candidature will be considered under general merit.
- 4. Fee once paid to the University is not refundable under any circumstances
- 5. Candidates who are in service should submit their application through proper channel.
- 6. Incomplete applications will be rejected. No further correspondence will be entertained in this regard.
- 7. The Admission card duly signed by the concerned Chairperson / Director will be issued to the candidate on the date of examination from 9.00 am onwards.
- 8. The eligibility list will be announced in the University website on 02nd June 2015.
- 9. Only the eligible candidates will be allowed to write the Entrance Test.
- 10. The candidates who had qualified in the Entrance Tests conducted as per earlier Notifications will have to apply afresh.
- 11. The University reserves the right to fill or not to fill the seats.
