TUMKUR UNIVERSITY (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS GOVERNING UNDER GRADUATE DEGREE PROGRAMMES

Offered under Semester Scheme with
Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) – 2015-16

(As per Section 44(1) of Karnataka State University Act 2000)

Preamble: The Regulations Governing Under-Graduate Degree Programmes offered by Tumkur University under Semester Scheme with Choice Based Credit System (CBCS), 2015-2016, was earlier notified on 11.07.2016 (Vide notification No. TU/AC/2015-16/1206) with an aim to consider and adopt Semester Scheme, Choice Based Credit System (CBCS), flexibility in Curriculum Development and Examination Reforms in terms of adopting Continuous Evaluation Pattern by reducing the weightage on the semester-end examination so that students enjoy a de-stressed learning environment.

The University is now desirous of starting B.Sc. Fashion & Apparel Design programme, and in this context the Board of Studies (BoS) for B.Sc. Fashion & Apparel Design programme has prepared and recommended the eligibility conditions for admission to the B.Sc. Fashion & Apparel Design programme. The Academic Council and the Syndicate in its meeting held on 19.02.2020 has accorded the recommendations made by the BoS and has further recommended to insert this provision in the existing regulation. Hence, the following amendments in the regulations are proposed.

1. Short title and Commencement:-

- (1) These regulations may be called the Tumkur University (Amendment) Regulations governing Under-Graduate Degree Programmes offered under semester scheme with Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) - (2015-2016).
- (2) They shall come into force from the date of assent of the Governor and Chancellor.

2. Amendment of Section 03: In the Regulations governing the Under Graduate programmes under Semester scheme with CBCS, in Section 03, after clause 3.7, the following shall be inserted namely,

3.8: For B.Sc. Fashion & Apparel Design Programme

- i) A Candidate who has passed the Pre-University examination conducted by the Pre-University Education Board in the State of Karnataka or two years Job Oriented Courses conducted by the Board of Vocational Education of any State Government or any other examination considered as equivalent thereto.
- ii) Lateral entry: Candidate with 3 years Diploma in Apparel Design & Fabrication Technology/Textile Technology/ Garment Technology /Costume & Fashion Design/ Handloom Technology or any other 03 years Diploma considered as equivalent and recognized by the state or Central Government are eligible for admission directly to the III semester of the B.Sc. Fashion & Apparel Design Course.

3. Amendment of Section 4: In the Regulations governing the Undergraduate programmes under semester scheme with CBCS, in the section 4.4(B) the following amendments are made.

4.4(B) Group-II: Study of 3 subjects of equal importance (Optional subjects) in case of B.Sc and B.A and study of specified number of subjects as courses in case of B.B.M., B.Com and B.S.W, and B.C.A.

However for B.Sc. Fashion & Apparel Design programme, the Group II subjects shall be offered as specified in the course structure and matrix for B.Sc. Fashion & Apparel Design programme. Further, a student of B.Sc. Fashion & Apparel Design shall undertake internship after the completion of fourth semester and project work shall be undertaken after the completion of fifth semester under the supervision of a qualified staff and a report shall be submitted to the university before the commencement of V and VI Semester Examination respectively.
