The eligible candidates for admission to Ph.D. Programme in Commerce are hereby informed that the Counselling and Allotment of Research Supervisor will be conducted as per the following schedule:

The allotment of Research Supervisor shall be made strictly on the basis of Merit & availability of vacancies, under the respective Research Supervisor, and the applicable reservation roster in accordance with the Government of Karnataka reservation/roster policy and the relevant University Regulations.

For the purpose of reservation and allotment of Ph.D seats, the Vertical Reservation under the 400-Point Roster prescribed by the Government of Karnataka shall be strictly followed in accordance with the Government of Karnataka order DPAR 02 SBC 2026 dated 13.05.2026 issued by the Karnataka Department of Personnel and Administrative Reforms and other applicable Government Orders/Circulars and University Regulations in force.

Vacancies and Reservation Roster

Candidates who remain **absent / late arrival** for the counselling shall not be considered for allotment of a Research Supervisor, and no subsequent claim in this regard shall ordinarily be entertained.

Candidates are required to **choose their Research Supervisor** keeping in view of their **proposed area of research, research interests, specialization, and the subject expertise of the concerned Supervisor**, so as to facilitate effective supervision and quality research. **Mutual consent of both the Research Supervisor and the candidate shall be essential** for the allotment of a Supervisor. Accordingly, the Supervisor allotment shall be finalized only after obtaining the **willingness/consent of the concerned Supervisor and the acceptance of the candidate**, subject to the availability of vacancies under the Supervisor, merit, applicable reservation roster, and the Ph.D. Regulations of the University.

3. **Valid Caste/Category / Income Certificate** issued by the competent authority, wherever applicable.
4. **Copy of the Aadhaar Card.**
5. **Two recent passport-size photographs.**
6. **One Plastic Document folder / bag for keeping all the documents**
7. **Any other relevant certificates/documents required for verification of eligibility and reservation claims.**

The Candidates claiming reservation are specifically advised to ensure that their **Caste/Category and other supporting certificates are valid and issued by the competent authority as prescribed by the Government of Karnataka**. Failure to produce the required original and valid documents at the time of counselling may result in non-consideration of the claim under the respective category.

Candidates who wish to pursue the Ph.D programme as **Full-Time Research Scholars** in the Department shall submit a written request in advance to the Chairman of the Department expressing their willingness. Such requests will be considered based on eligibility, merit, availability of research facilities, and the applicable University Ph.D. Regulations.

All concerned candidates are therefore directed to report at the venue **well in advance** and cooperate for the smooth conduct of the counselling and Supervisor allotment process.
